



WHAT IS THE EBF

THE ECONOMICS AND BUSINESS FACULTY ASSOCIATION (EBF) IS THE STUDENT ASSOCIATION FOR ALL STUDENTS AT THE FACULTY OF ECONOMICS AND BUSINESS (FEB) AT THE UNIVERSITY OF GRONINGEN. SINCE ITS FOUNDING IN 2007, THE EBF HAS GROWN INTO A COMMUNITY OF AROUND 5,000 MEMBERS, OFFERING A VARIETY OF ACTIVITIES AND SERVICES TO SUPPORT THEIR STUDIES, CAREER OPPORTUNITIES, AND SOCIAL LIFE.

WITH ABOUT 180 ACTIVE MEMBERS ACROSS 31 COMMITTEES AND BOARDS, THE EBF IS THE LARGEST STUDY ASSOCIATION IN GRONINGEN. ITS ACTIVITIES FOCUS ON ACADEMIC, PROFESSIONAL, AND PERSONAL DEVELOPMENT AND ARE DIVIDED INTO FOUR MAIN AREAS: STUDY, CAREER, RECREATION, AND INTERNATIONAL. EVENTS LIKE THE EBF CONFERENCE, EBF/MARUG RECRUITMENT DAYS, AND THE EBF CONSULTANCY TOUR HELP STUDENTS CONNECT THEORY WITH PRACTICE.

BEYOND FORMAL EVENTS, THE EBF ALSO ORGANIZES SOCIAL ACTIVITIES, INCLUDING MONTHLY SOCIALS, TRIPS FOR ACTIVE MEMBERS, AND PARTIES. THE ASSOCIATION ALSO PROVIDES INTERNATIONAL OPPORTUNITIES, SUCH AS THE EUROPEAN STUDY RESEARCH AND INTERNATIONAL BUSINESS RESEARCH. TO CATER TO THE DIVERSE INTERESTS WITHIN FEB, THE EBF HAS FOUR SUB-ASSOCIATIONS FOCUSED ON SPECIFIC FIELDS: MARUG, FSG, TEMA, AND VESTING.


WHY SHOULD I JOIN A COMMITTEE?

WHAT IS THE DIFFERENCE BETWEEN A STUDENT ASSOCIATION AND A STUDY ASSOCIATION?

A student association, such as a social club or sports association, is open to students from all studies, and often focuses on recreation and social events. Study associations, such as the EBF, are only open to students who are studying at the specific faculty that the association serves. The EBF not only organises social, but also career and study related events. The EBF offers the whole package! It is also good to know that there is no initiation period ("ontgroening") when you become a(n) (active) member!
